Global Mission Pioneers are the unsung heroes of Adventist Mission. And then they win the confidence of the people and bid them to follow Jesus. These pioneers embed themselves as Jesus did incarnationally in the community. They sacrifice their time and efforts to live simply and bring others into a loving relationship with God.
