sc. **01**

"For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen" (Romans 11:36).

sc. **02**

In this verse, Paul presents the three key aspects of true worship. First, he states, "Of Him... are all things" (Romans 11:36), teaching us that everything belongs to God, a truth established from the very first verse of the Bible: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Genesis 1:1). The phrase "In the beginning" implies that God existed before creation and is self-sufficient, needing nothing from anyone.

Next, Paul explains, "Through Him... are all things" (Romans 11:36). This means that everything we have comes not from our own strength, wisdom, or ability but from God's Providence who empowers and equips us. To grasp this, we must ask ourselves: Did I achieve this alone? Am I self-made? Do I possess what I have solely by my own efforts? All good things come from God's loving hand.

Finally, Paul teaches, "To Him are all things" (Romans 11:36). Since everything is of God through God, it should all be dedicated to Him and His purposes, His cause. While it may be easy to intellectually acknowledge that all things are His and are for Him, truly living this out requires surrendering our lives to Jesus and the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

sc. **03**

Like Paul, let us praise God, saying, "For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things!" As we return the tithe and Promise offerings, may we put our desires last and God first.
