Pray for our Global Mission pioneers and the people with which they work. The call to go and tell the world that Jesus is coming cannot be maintained or expanded unless we continue to worship God with our offerings regularly. Offerings are extremely important because they support various initiatives the tithe cannot support. That is why offerings should ideally be given as “Promise”—a covenant with God to faithfully, regularly return a chosen percentage of our earnings in addition to the tithe.

You are also partnering with Talessa and other Global Mission pioneers every time you distribute your offering according to what is suggested by the Combined Offering Plan: 50-60% of your total offering to your Local Church, 20-30% to your Conference and Union, and 20% to the World Mission Fund, also known as the World Budget. This planned regular offering will support all the programs that God’s church has instituted to reach every nation, tribe, tongue, and people, so Jesus can come.

As we worship God with our Tithes and “Promise” offerings, let us pray for the work of Global Mission Pioneers. May we put our desires last and God first.
