

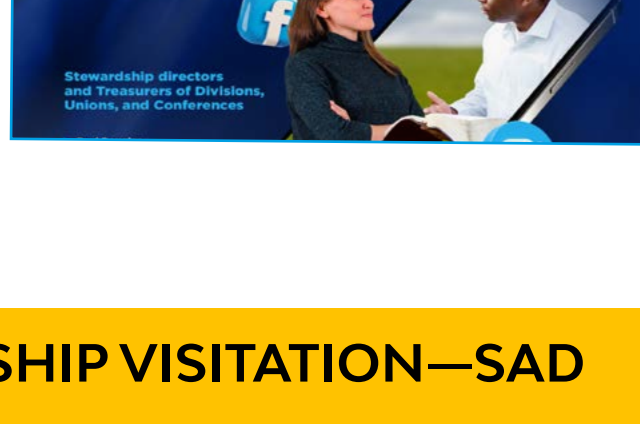

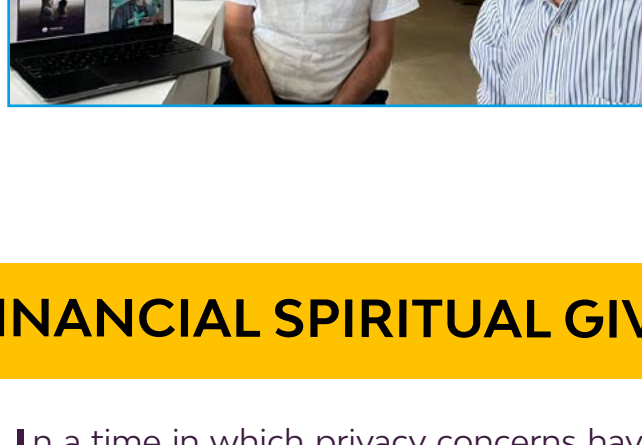
## ONLINE GOD FIRST CONGRESS

## STEWARDSHIP LEADERSHIP VISITATION—SAD



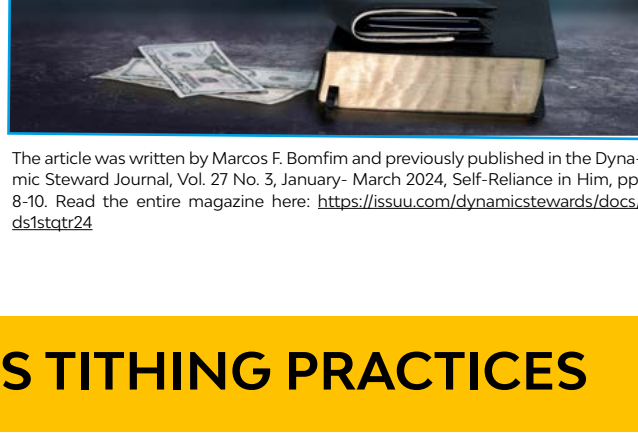
### South American Division

### LACK OF CONTROL

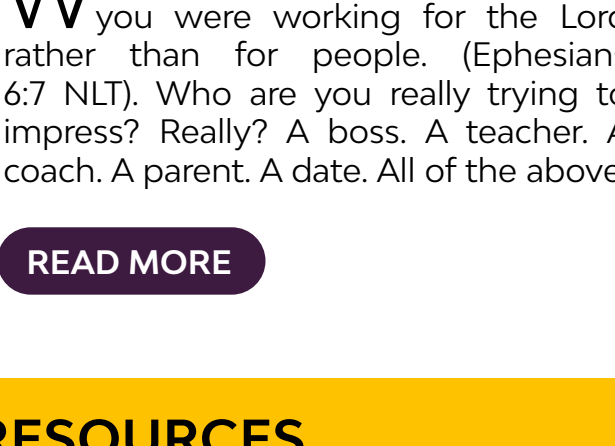


#### Illustrates Trust

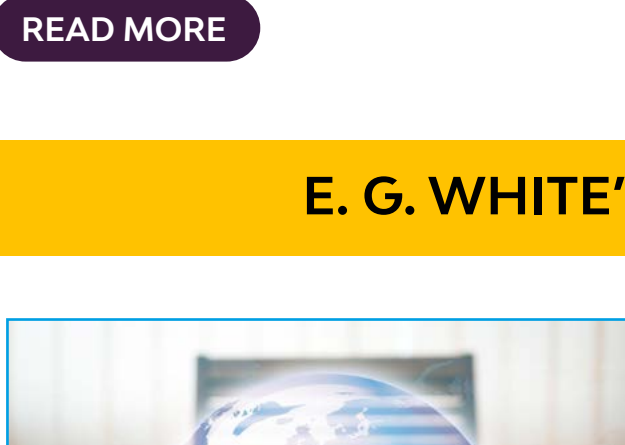

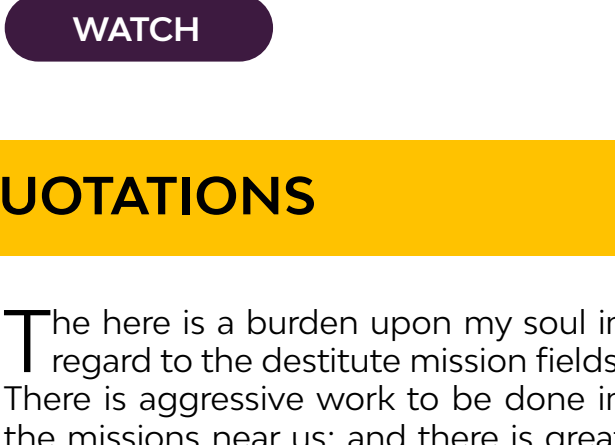
