Are you expected to find a way to get money anyway so that you may fulfill your vows? Should you sell something you own in order to give? Ask your boss for an advance? Borrow money from a friend?

Can someone still be considered a tither and a promisor without having an income?

Of course! The idea is pretty simple. Being a tither and a Promisor is a decision made from a heart that accepts God as the Owner and Source of all material blessings. This acceptance depends on your submission to Him and to His word. It's not about money! Motion graphics and illustrations.

God will never expect tithe and Promise from someone who hasn't received anything from Him. Once again:

We don't tithe in order to be blessed. Actually, we tithe because we have already been blessed!

Same thing goes for your Promise. In both cases, a previously established percentage is offered from what you receive from God. So, the tithe for zero income is zero. The Promise for zero income is, once again, zero!

And, in this case, even when you return nothing, you're still considered faithful.

But, hey! There is something you can do about it. You may pray to the Lord, and remind Him that you are already a tither and a Promisor; that following His Word you will return to Him as tithe and Promise determined percentages of all that He will give you. Then, ask him to give you an income, if He wants you to help forwarding His work in this world. For we know that every giving starts with God's giving.
