But many other nomadic communities throughout Eastern Africa still have yet to hear the gospel message. Through our offerings that we can support Global Mission pioneers like Lawrence. Every time we assign our offering to a specific project, the benefit of those funds will be restricted to that project only. But how can we widen the usefulness of our offerings?

If you live in countries where the Combined Offering Plan is practiced, every time you give your offering as an unassigned offering, it is automatically distributed according to what is suggested in Acts 1:8, locally, regionally, and internationally. Particles of your offering will equally bless all missionary projects, ministries, and Global Mission pioneers like Lawrence.

But if you live in countries that have not yet adopted the Combined Offering Plan, you may choose to manually distribute your offering according to what this plan suggests. If this is your choice, then 50-60% of your offering will support the mission of your local church; 20-30% of your offering will support the regional missionary needs of your Conference and Union, and 20% will be assigned to the World Mission Fund or World Budget.

By following this system of distribution of offerings, we help God's mission to grow sustainably and equitably throughout the world, and not only in places we know or like. Through this unselfish distribution of offerings, we contribute to spreading God's love to places we could never know or go ourselves.
