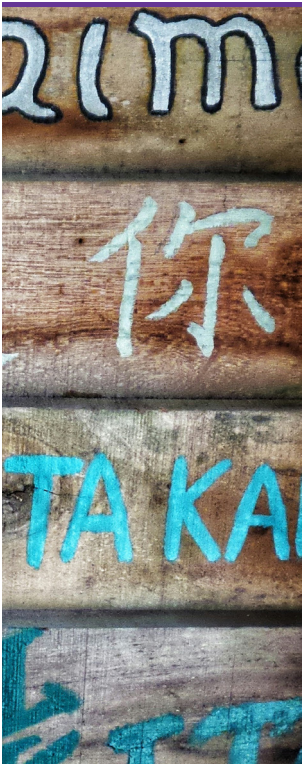


THE LANGUAGE OF LOVE
