It is also ternatic because it is regulated by the proportional becreentual system, as alluded to by the Bible and blained in the Spirit of Prophecy. Those who adopt "Promise" Offering system establish in prayer to urn to God a determined percentage of their ome, of every increase, as an offering, besides the te, for a certain period, usually one year. Then, after speriod ends, they will recommit the same or a ferent percentage for another period. vowing that way, they reveal that they want to come partners with God, also leaving the decision but WHEN and HOW MUCH to give to Him. They will e as frequently as He gives them and a fixed oportion of what He gives. The more God blesses em, the more they will give to advance His kingdom. hversely, they are not expected to give anything if ey don't receive anything.
